## **Excursion programme Marine Resources: Coastal administration and fish farming**

The Norwegian Coastal Administration - NCA (Kystverket) is the national agency for coastal management, maritime safety and -communication in Norway. NCA is present along the whole of the Norwegian coast, and we will visit a traffic central who is located at Kvitsøy, just outside Stavanger.

The Norwegian aquaculture production is large, and we will also visit a site for farming salmon. The farming facilities are developed to be stronger and bigger, so they could be located in more open fjords. We will visit one of the biggest companies, Grieg Seafood, when they are feeding the fish.

The bus leaves Stavanger Forum 13:30 and return 17:30. The travelling will be 30 minute by bus and then a boat trip of 30 minute who includes lunch.

There is a maximum capacity of 43 persons on this tour.
