Workshops

There will be workshops in two places in Kristiansand, Rosegården Theatre House and Samsen culture centre: www.samsen.com

Rosegården:

These premises can accommodate about 60 participants, spread over three courses. This is a charming place, an old factory which has been converted. The building is mostly used by amateur theatre groups.

Arne Hadland is the contact person here, and he makes sure everything is well organised, also the serving of lunch.

Samsen Culture Centre:

This building can accommodate the rest of the participants spread over four courses. Your lunch will come from Café Nattmanden. This is the venue for the concert on Thursday evening.

The course instructors are professionals and artists in their own fields. Most of them have long experience with communication and young people.

Everyone puts their name down for a course on an enrolment form. On every course there will be an assistant who is also a social contact for all the participants.

Performance

For performance the instructor is a group, called LOOP LOOP LOOP. It is a group with Morten Liene, educated from LeCoq in Paris, Tori Wrånes, multi artist and Laura Christina Brøvig Vallenes, education from the academy of puppet theatre.

Clown

The clown is from Denmark and her name is Birgit Bang Mogensen.

Dance

The dance instructor is Ketil Gudim. He has previously danced for the National Ballet. He will be teaching you combat and stick fight. 'Dance' with sticks.

Film

The film instructor is Danckert Monrad-Krohn jr. He has held many courses for young people and several of these films have won international prizes.

Art

The artist, Anne Kathrine Solbakken, has taught young people on several courses. She herself has worked in Denmark and Greenland, and she produces colourful pictures, usually installation art.

Music

Jon Halvor Bjørnseth is musician and composer, and will have the workshop for music. You use your own instruments, and you will do lot of imaginative experiments with sounds, ensemble, improvisation, composing and making a concert.

Song/Choir

For all of you who like to sing, alone or in a group, it is perfect with the workshop of choir. You learn to use your voice, new songs and you will have a nice time together with a lot of the other participants.

Juggling

The name of the instructor for juggling will come.
