

Getting to Aviemore

Being situated on the main road, rail and bus routes between Inverness and the South Aviemore is easily accessible. It is also under an hour from Inverness airport.

By air

Inverness is the nearest airport and is served by direct flights from Glasgow, Edinburgh, London (Heathrow, Gatwick & Luton airports), Birmingham, Manchester, Bristol, Leeds / Bradford, Belfast and Dublin as well as the Scottish Islands. By Rail

Aviemore is about 40 minutes south of Inverness on the main rail route that connects Inverness with Perth, Edinburgh, Glasgow and London. Trains to and from Scottish cities run approximately every 2 hours and to London twice daily (1 sleeper service) www.firstscotrail.com gives timetables. The Aviemore Highland Resort is approximately 200m opposite the station

By coach

Aviemore is about 40 minutes south of Inverness on the main bus route that connects Inverness with Perth, Edinburgh and Glasgow with onward connections to England. Scottish Citylink services run approximately every hour with Megabus services approximately every two hours www.scottishcitylink.com and www.megabus.com give timetables.

By Road

Aviemore is on the main A9 trunk road that connects Inverness with Perth. From Edinburgh follow the A90 / M90 or from Glasgow follow the M80 / A80 / A9 to Perth from where the A9 leads directly to Aviemore. From Aberdeen follow the A96 towards Inverness and join the A95 at Keith which leads south to Aviemore.

Approximate journey times:-

From Inverness – 40 minutes

From Aberdeen – 3 hours

From Perth – 2 hours

From Edinburgh – 3 ½ hours

From Glasgow – 4 hours

The Aviemore Highland Resort is located behind the Cairngorm Hotel which is located on the west side of the main road through the village, opposite the railway station.
